Purpose of Plan



The purpose of the Subsistence Plan for Surface Land Access & Use is to provide full access to surface land leased by Donlin Gold LLC for subsistence use, subject to the regulatory, safety and other operational needs of the Donlin Gold Project (Project).

This plan is for surface lands for the Jungjuk Port, Donlin-Jungjuk road, the Airport Road, and the Mine Site (core operating area)

The Plan is required by the TKC agreement for TKC lands. Donlin Gold has expanded the plan to include all lands between the port and mine.

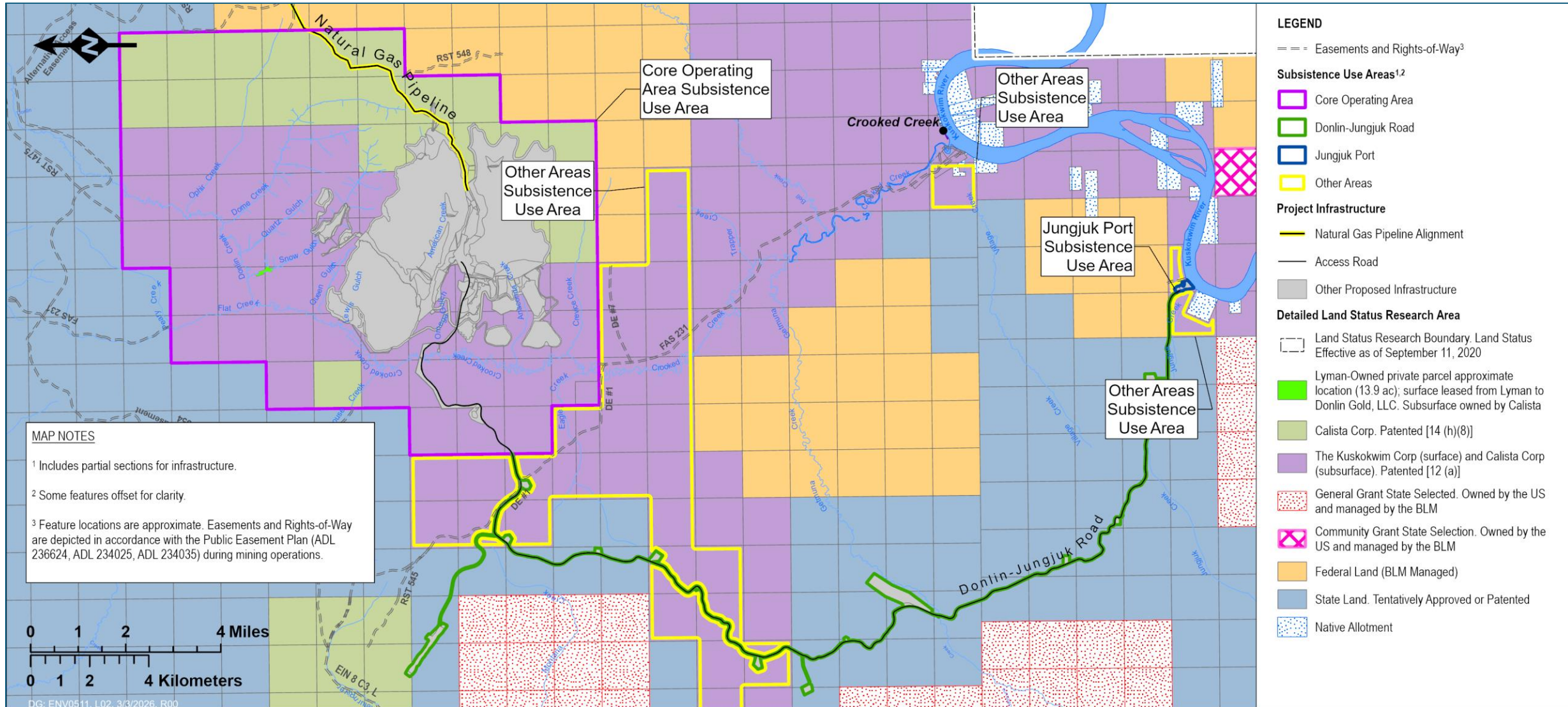

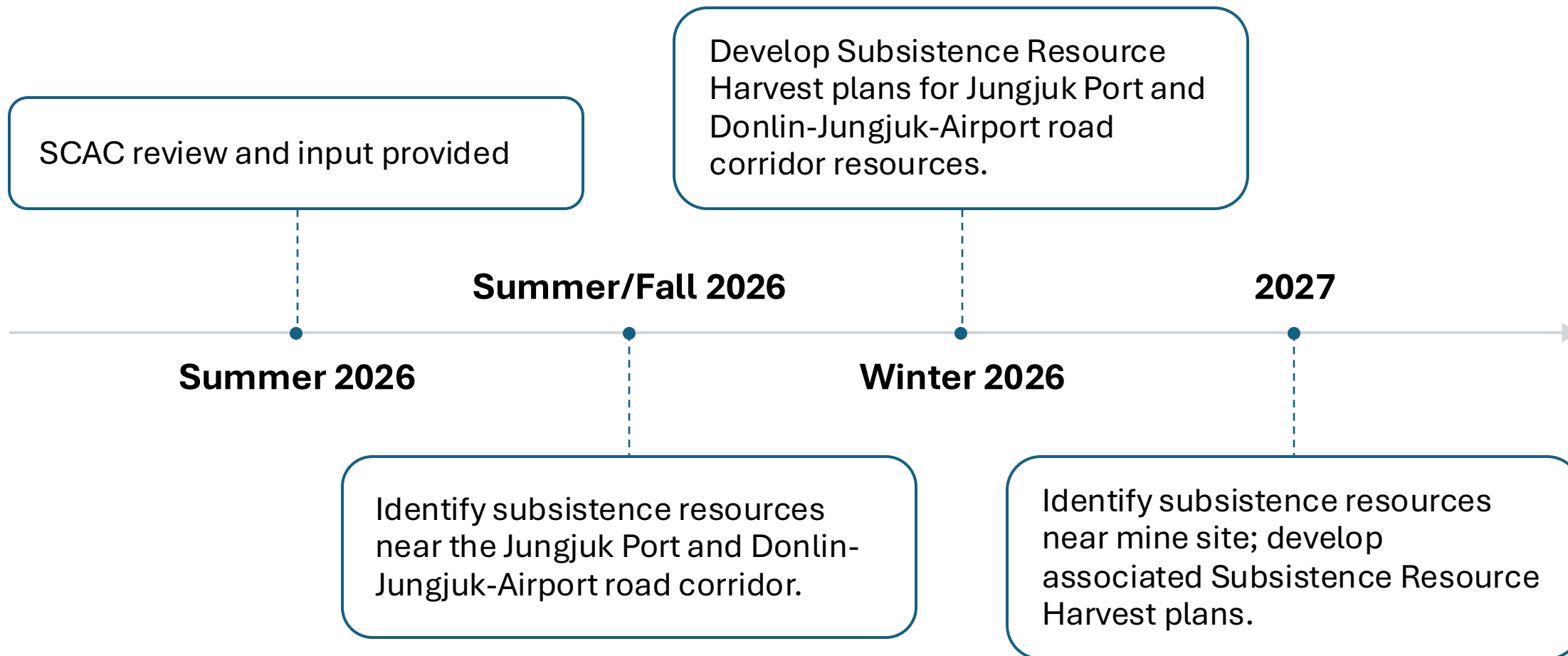

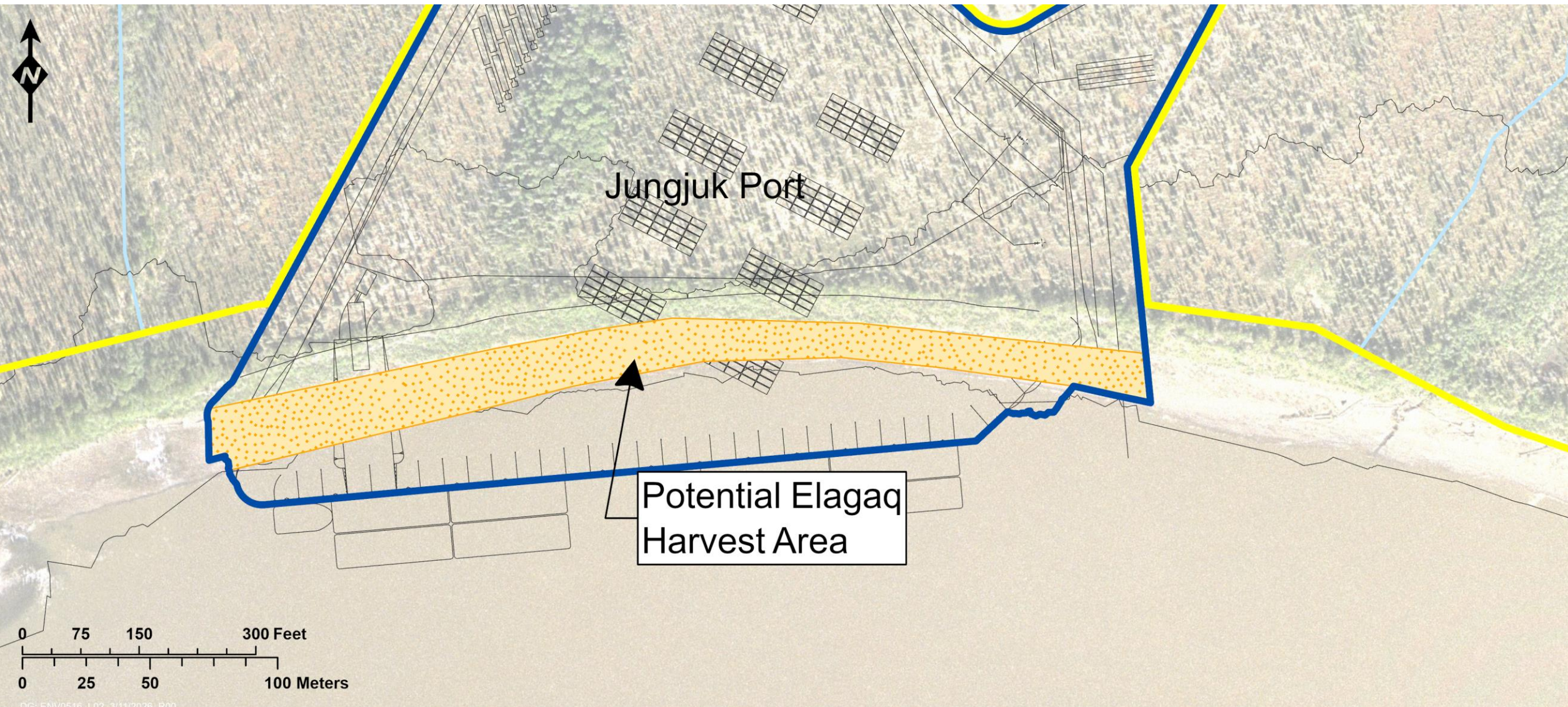

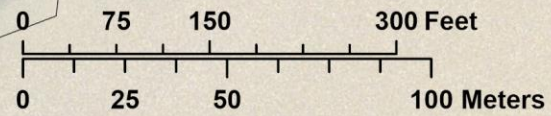


Example - Elagaq Harvest Plan
